

## **Generations of Grace:**

The following lesson was taught in children's church this Sunday, **Dec 5**

**MESSAGE:** Paul testifies to the gospel in Rome

**PASSAGE:** Acts 28: 11-31

**PRINCIPLE:** The gospel keeps spreading, but only those who believe it are saved.

### **ASK YOUR CHILD:**

Why could Paul tell about Jesus so much even though he was a prisoner in Rome? How did Paul first describe the gospel to the Jews? How did Paul next describe the gospel to the Jews? What did Paul use to explain the gospel to the Jews? According to Isaiah, why did most of the Jews refuse to believe? Did prison or rejection stop Paul from telling about Jesus?

**APPLY:** Humans can be put in chains, but can the gospel ever be locked up? Are you able to use the Bible to tell about Jesus? What can you do to get better at this? Do you consistently hear God's Word? Has it changed your thoughts, words, and behavior?

信息：保羅在羅馬為福音作見證

經文：使徒行傳 28: 11 – 31

信念：福音正被廣傳，但只有相信的人才能被救

向你子女問：雖然保羅是一個在羅馬的囚犯，為什麼他能夠詳細地述說耶穌？保羅初時怎樣將福音描述給猶太人？之後，保羅怎樣將福音描述給猶太人？保羅運用什麼來解釋福音給猶太人聽？據以賽亞所說，為什麼大部分的猶太人拒絕相信？監獄鎖綁或人們的拒絕，有沒有阻止保羅去宣揚耶穌？

應用：人可以被鎖綁，但有什麼能夠將福音鎖起來？你是否能夠用聖經去傳講耶穌？你可以作什麼而令你在這事上有進步？你是否不斷聽到神的話語？神的話語有沒有改變你的思想說話和行為？
