

Generations of Grace:

The following lesson was taught in children's church this Sunday, **Feb 25, 2024**

MESSAGE: Jesus teaches the parable of landowner

PASSAGE: Mark 12:1-12

PRINCIPLE: People who reject Jesus' authority will be destroyed.

ASK YOUR CHILD: What did the vineyard represent? Who did the different people represent? What did God expect from Israel? Why should the tenants have respected the son? What would God do to the leaders when they killed Jesus? After the parable, how did Jesus prove He is the Messiah? How was Jesus like the stone rejected by the builders? How is the cornerstone both a blessing and a curse?

APPLY: Is your life producing the "fruit of righteousness," or are you, like Israel, squandering God's provision, resources, and blessings? How do you respond when confronted with your sin? Is your life built on Jesus? List some of your habits that need to change in order to be in line with Jesus the Cornerstone. How has God blessed you? Do you use those blessings to please yourself or to please Him?

信息：耶穌教導關於園主的比喻

經文：馬可福音 12:1-12

信念：拒絕耶穌權柄的人將會被毀滅

向你子女問：葡萄園代表什麼？不同的人代表誰？神對以色列有什麼期望？園戶為什麼要尊重園主的兒子？當領袖們殺了耶穌時，神會怎樣對待他們呢？講完比喻之後，耶穌如何證明祂是彌賽亞？耶穌在哪些方面是像被匠人丟棄的那一塊石頭一樣？房角石為何既是祝福又是咒詛？

應用：你的生活是否結出了“義的果子”，或者你是像以色列一樣，浪費了神的供應、資源和祝福？當你面對自己的罪時，你會怎樣反應？你的生命是以耶穌為中心嗎？列出一些你需要改變的習慣，好使你能像“房角石”（耶穌）。神已經如何祝福你？你用這些祝福來取悅自己還是取悅神？
